Connecticut, New York, and New Jersey seem to be doing well in controlling the spread of COVID-19. As a result, many people are becoming comfortable enough to start planning and taking their vacations, and many are vacationing out of the state in which they reside.

In an effort to continue to control the spread of COVID-19, the Governors of Connecticut, New York, and New Jersey have instituted a Travel Quarantine Advisory.

The Travel Quarantine Advisory means that if you travel to one of the impacted states, which has high numbers of COVID, you will be required to self-quarantine for a period of 14 days following your return to Connecticut.

The self-quarantine is mandatory and there will be no exceptions.

As of today, the following states are reporting high numbers of COVID cases and are on the Travel Quarantine Advisory:
